ENGINEER PLATOON IN COUNTERMOBILITY OPERATIONS (EPCMO) COURSE 2025

1 GENERAL

The Finnish Defence Forces (FDF) Countermobility Centre of Excellence is pleased to inform you that the "Engineer Platoon in Countermobility Operations 2025" is scheduled to be conducted from 25th to 29th of October 2025 at Kainuu Brigade in Kajaani, Finland.

The aim of the course is to share experience and teach how The Finnish Defence Forces use engineer units in countermobility operations on squad to platoon level, and how these units are trained.
