INVITATION TO THE GLOBAL TRUST SUMMIT 2026, NAIROBI, KENYA

The Government of Kenya, through the State Department for Foreign Affairs, in partnership with Strathmore University, the Open Government Partnership, the Ford Foundation and the Konrad-Adenauer-Stiftung, will convene the Global Trust Summit in Nairobi from 22-23 October 2026.

Convened under the theme "Weaving Trust: Binding Strands for a Stronger Global Order," the Summit responds to a widening global trust deficit and declining confidence in governments, multilateral institutions and media ecosystems that is fuelling polarisation, weakening regulatory compliance, and straining the international cooperation needed to address shared global challenges.

Outcomes from these deliberations will inform the Nairobi Trust Declaration on Peace and Sustainable Development, a shared framework for rebuilding trust as the foundation for institutional sustainability, economic growth and effective global cooperation.

As both the court of last resort and the guardian of constitutional review, the Supreme Court of Estonia anchors the rule of law and impartial justice in a leading digital democracy, where public confidence in the institutions of state rests upon the supremacy of the law, work on Democracy and Public Institutions that closely aligns with the Summit's thematic focus. 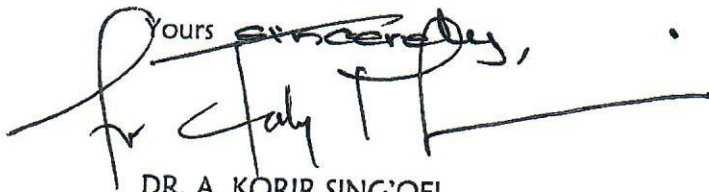
participation would add valuable perspective to our collective effort to rebuild trust across institutions.
