2.1 Description of the Procurement Object	implementing ScC within the Estonian Prison Service, focusing on the resocialization of youth through a family/system-centered approach. Training and guidance are intended for prison service staff working with incarcerated or probationary youth up to 21 years of age, and older when applicable. The service shall include a system analysis, training, ongoing support during implementation, coaching, follow-up training, and training of ScC trainers within the institution to quarantee it's continuity.		
2.2 Deadline and/or Schedule	The contract period is 16 months from the contract date.

4.1 Clarifications	Interested parties have the right to request clarifications on the small procurement documents by sending inquiries to <b>peter.gornischeff@justdigi.ee</b> . The contracting authority will respond to inquiries within three business days, sharing both the questions and responses with all individuals invited to submit a proposal.
4.2 Proposal Format and Submission	The proposal should include a proposal form with confirmations (attached to the invitation to submit a proposal).  The Bidder is responsible for all costs related to the preparation and submission of the proposal, as well as the risk of timely submission.  The submitted proposal must be valid for at least 60 days from the deadline for proposal submission.  The proposal must be submitted electronically to the email address peter.gornischeff@justdigi.ee by 10.03.2025 at 09:00 according to time zone in Estonia (GMT+2)  Please inform us if you decide not to submit a proposal.

The proposal will remain confidential until the signing of the procurement contract.
The Bidder should indicate which information in the proposal is considered a trade secret and justify the designation of information as confidential. The Bidder may not designate the price or individual component prices as a trade secret. The contracting authority will not disclose the contents of proposals in the confidential sections covered by trade secrets and will not be responsible for the disclosure of trade secrets in areas not marked as confidential by the Bidder.
The contracting authority will open all preliminary proposals submitted by the deadline and verify their compliance with the requirements specified in the small-scale procurement document.
If the Bidder or proposal does not meet the conditions stated in the small-scale procurement document, the contracting authority will reject the proposal
The contracting authority may negotiate with all tenderers whose proposals meet the requirements, discussing the content, schedule, and cost of the proposal. Requirements and evaluation criteria specified for the Bidder and proposal in the small-scale procurement document will not be subject to negotiation.  During negotiations, the contracting authority will ensure equal treatment of all Bidders and will not disclose any information obtained in negotiations that may give one Bidder an advantage over others. The contracting authority will not disclose confidential information provided by the Bidder to other participants without the Bidder's consent.  Negotiations can be held either electronically or in meetings as agreed upon by the contracting authority and the Bidders. Oral
agreed upon by the contracting authority and the Bidders. Oral negotiations will be recorded.  Upon conclusion of negotiations, the contracting authority may invite Bidders to submit final, revised proposals.
The price shall constitute 80% (80 value points) and the quality 20% (20 value points) of the evaluation criteria. The Bidder who's 2 trainers have at least 10 years of experience working with families of juvenile delinquents in the forensic field shall get 100% of the quality evaluation criteria.  Maximum points shall be obtained with the cheapest total cost. Points for subsequent Bidders will be calculated using the formula: Bidder's score = total value of the lowest bid / total value of the specific bid x 80.
