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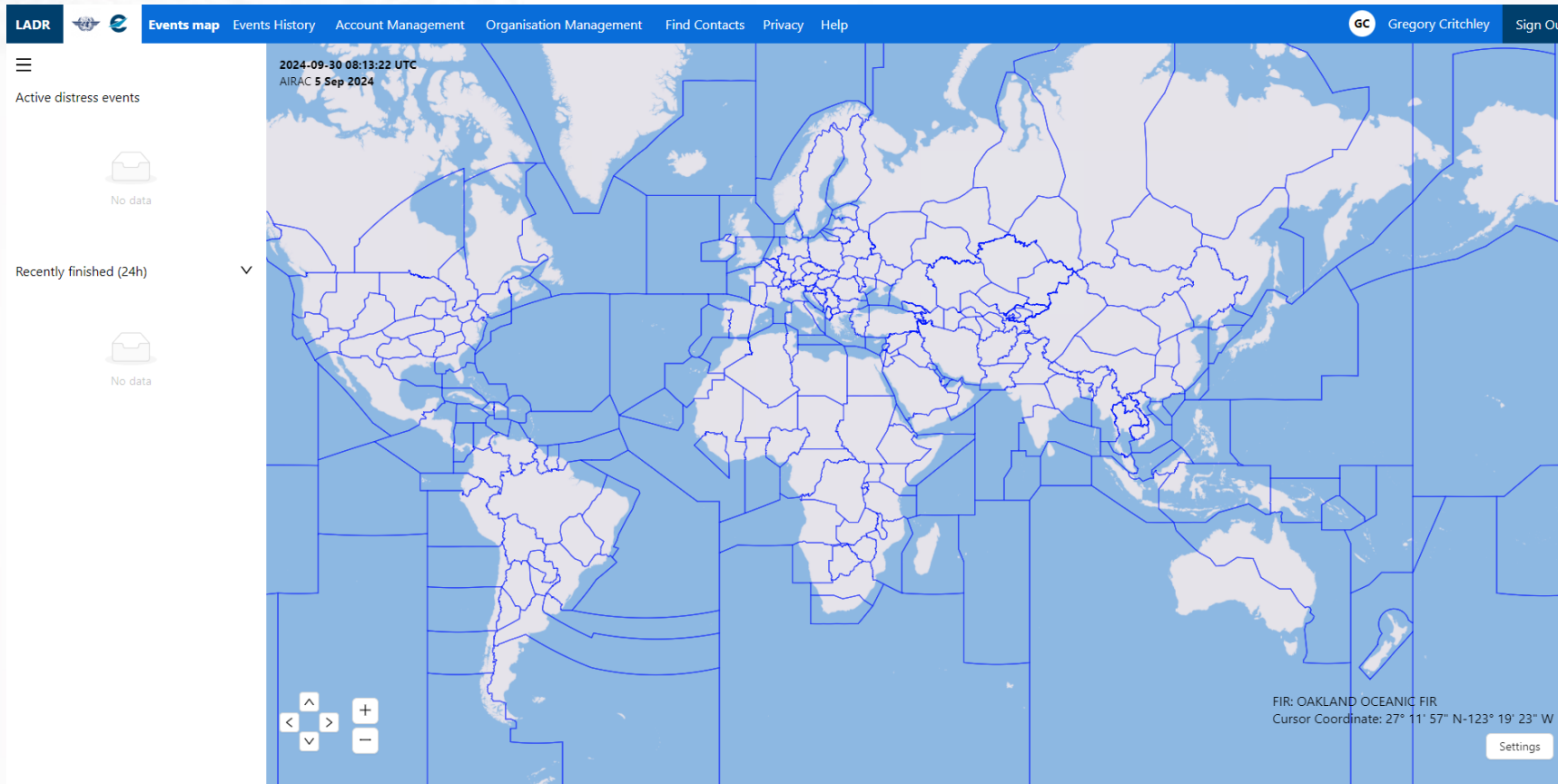

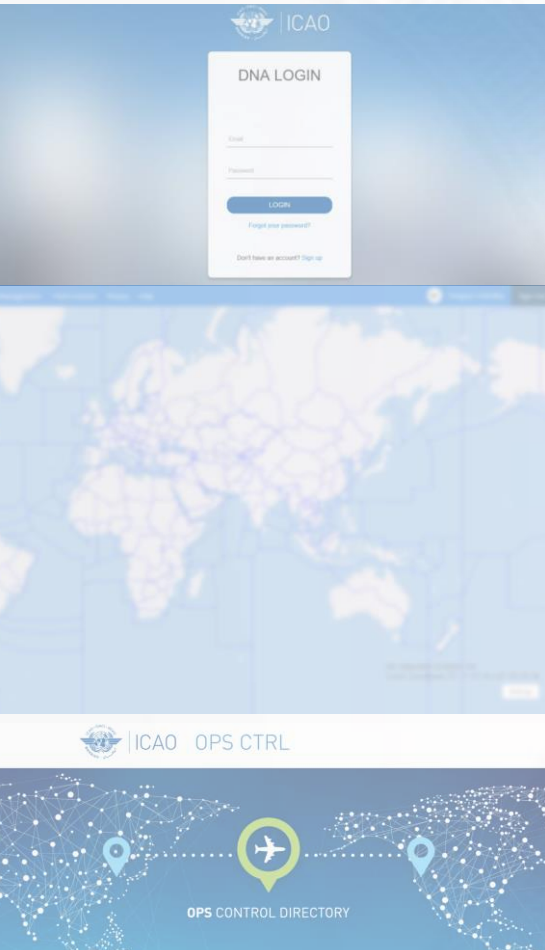

Steps for Registering

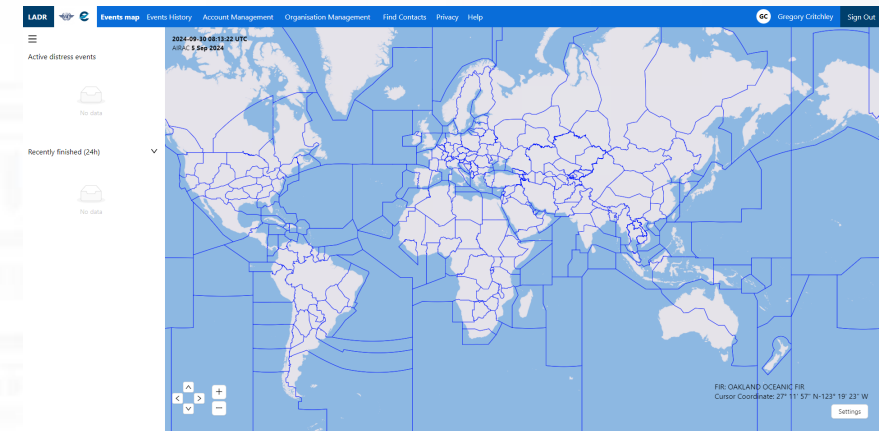


STEP 1:

UPDATE ACCOUNT and ORGANISATION MANAGEMENT



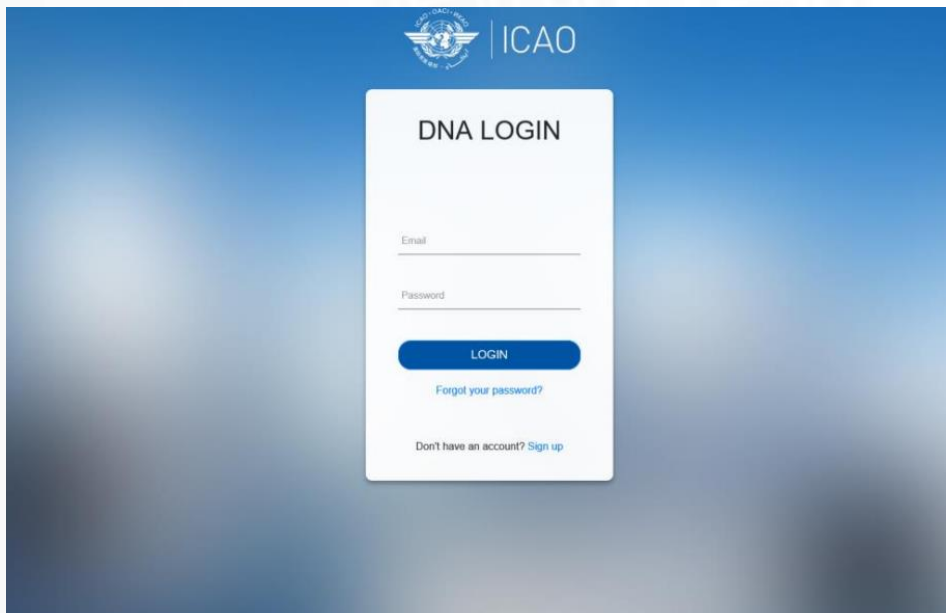

Airline Operator;

Air Navigation Service Provider (in LADR are represented via FIRs);

Search and Rescue Unit. – RCC

State Representatives



ACCESS to the LADR

Who will need the ACCESS within your Organisation. Each ANSP/RCC/Operator needs to create a Focal Point who will assign/appoint Users.

Focal Point

- Your Organisations administrator
- Rights to update you Organisations information
- Authorisers multiple users
- Viewer of information – Event and history
- Alert notification (Organizational contacts subscribed)

Authorised User

- Viewer of information – Event and history
- Alert Notification (Organizational contacts subscribed)
- Single point of contact
- Requires Focal point to grant access

FOCAL POINTS

How to register as a FOCAL point for your organisation

Information required for different sectors

Air Operator

ANSP – Air Navigation Service Provider

RCC – Rescue Coordination Centre

State Representative (in accordance with Annex 6, Part I, 6.18 who intend to provide access to authorized individuals not meeting any of the above descriptions.)

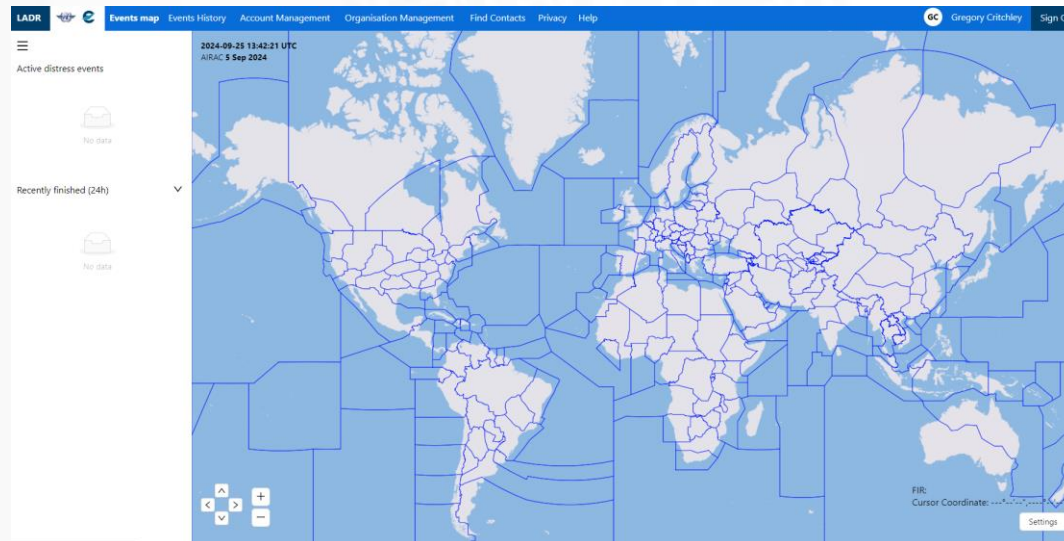

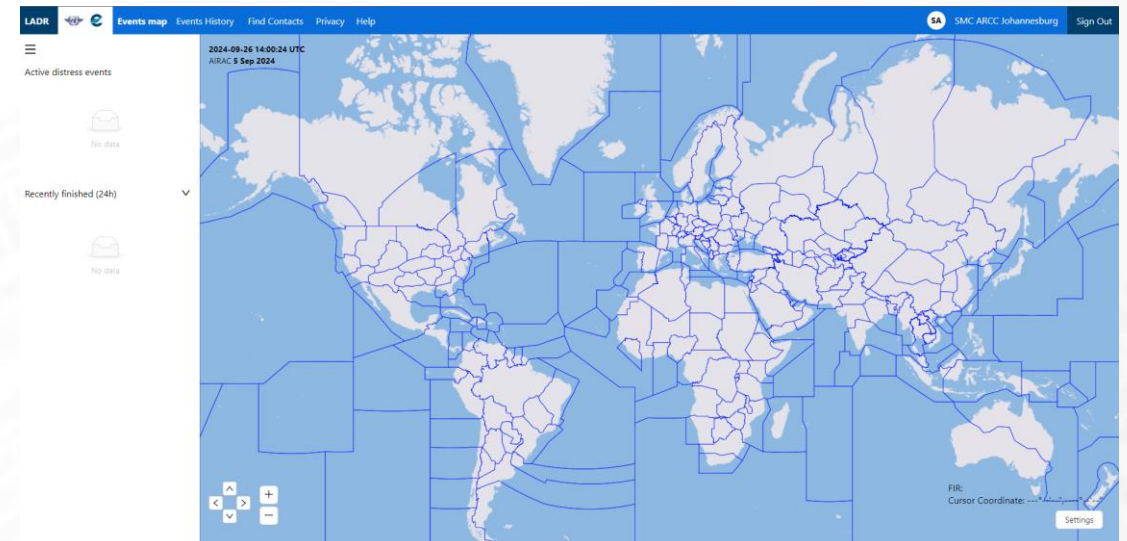

Authorised User View



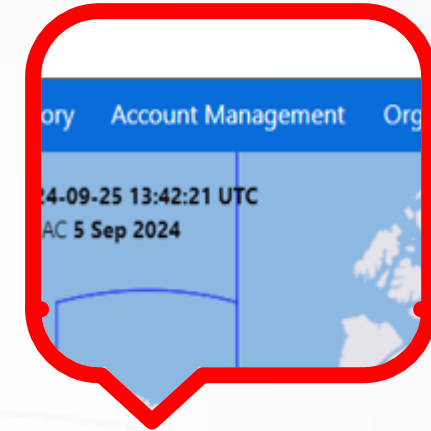

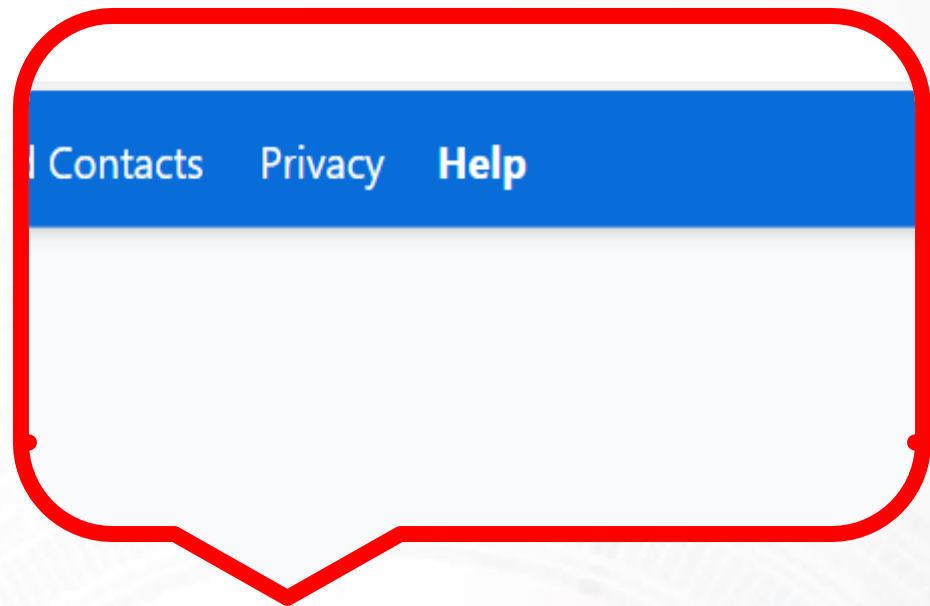
